Who is at risk of getting COVID-19?

- Seniors; 65+
- Infants (under the age of 1)
- Children with underlying medical conditions
- Anyone with an underlying medical condition

"We want to protect our family



You **qualify** for the vaccine if you:

- Are a healthcare/frontline workers
- Have more than one underlying medical condition
- Work in food service or transportation, or other high-risk environments
- * Note: the list is in order of who can receive the vaccine first based on Phase 1 in New York *

If you are pregnant or nursing, consult your doctor before getting the vaccine. If you are allergic to any component of the COVID-19 vaccine or have had allergic reactions to vaccines in the past, consult your doctor before receiving the vaccine.

- Heart conditions
- Down syndrome
- Obesity BMI> 40
- Sickle Cell Disease
- Immunocompromised (weak immune system)
- Diabetes

How to get Vaccinated

- Check if you are eligible
- Make an appointment with your local clinic
- Complete the New York State COVID-19 vaccine form
- Bring proof of eligibility in form of an ID card, Passport, etc.
- If you receive the Pfizer or Moderna, confirmed for your second dose



Types of Vaccines

- Pfizer- given in 2 doses, 21 days apart
- Moderna- given in 2 doses, 28 days apart
- Johnson and Johnson- given in 1 dose
